AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 38, ARTICLE 4,
DIVISION 1, SECTIONS 38-163(c) AND 38-163(g) OF THE CODE
OF THE CITY OF KENTWOOD ENTITLED "FIREWORKS"

THE CITY OF KENTWOOD ORDAINS:

Section 1. Amendment of Code. Chapter 38, Article 4, Division 1, Section 38-163(c) of the Code of Ordinances, City of Kentwood, Michigan, is amended to read as follows:

(c) Use of Consumer Fireworks Prohibited.

(1) On a day other than the day preceding, the day of, and the day after a national holiday, no person shall ignite, discharge, or use consumer fireworks in the City.

(2) On the day preceding, the day of, and the day after a national holiday, no person shall ignite, discharge, or use consumer fireworks between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m., consistent with Act 256.

A person who violates this subsection (c) shall be responsible for a municipal civil infraction and subject to a fine of \$500.

Section 2. Amendment of Code. Chapter 38, Article 4, Division 1, Section 38-163(g) of the Code of Ordinances, City of Kentwood, Michigan, is amended to read as follows:

(g) Violations, Fines and Penalties.

Except as provided in subsection 38-163(c), any person violating the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by up to ninety (90) days in jail and/or a fine up to \$500.00.

Section 3. Effective Date. In accordance with Section 5.5 of the City Charter, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency ordinance by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Commission and, hence, its effective date shall be the date of its publication.
