Jason informed them of the new programs and performance enhancements that have been achieved through our REGIS reorganization and system upgrades. He also talked about how REGIS can assist the clerks and assessors with their many duties.

Karen Brower, East Grand Rapids City Clerk stated, "*REGIS has so many layers and functions that most people don't even know about. Jason showed the members of the Kent County Clerks Association how REGIS can be used for precinct redistricting, cemetery management and even mailing labels for resident notifications.*"

Paul Gerndt, IT Supervisor for the City of Wyoming and Chair of our new REGIS Advisory Group also

attended the meetings and talked about the new level of member involvement in the critical operational decisions of REGIS.

In the future, the Advisory Group will be involved in decision making regarding new programs, operational issues and system upgrades. They will be the principal advisors to the REGIS Board.

We have completed our reorganization of REGIS and the first phase of our complete system upgrade. Phase one was accomplished ahead of schedule and below budget. Future less dramatic infrastructure up-

grades are planned in the coming months.

The feedback thus far on the upgrades have been very positive. Users have noticed increases in speed and we have had NO system failures or experienced any REGIS downtime since completion of phase one.

In addition, through the reorganization and establishment of the REGIS Advisory Group we have many more of our members participating in the leadership of REGIS. Each member community now has an active user representing the needs of their organization at the decision making level of REGIS.
