

**Mayor Jim Buck to Be  
Honored at GVMC Breakfast

Senator Carl Levin!**

After 41 years of service to the City of Grandville and 18 years as Chairman of Grand Valley Metro-

politan Council, Jim Buck will retire after the November election. Jim has served as mayor for 28 years and prior to that he was a member of the City Council for 13 years.

Our speaker and special guest for the breakfast will be United States Senator Carl Levin. Senator Levin has also announced his decision to retire at the end of his term.

Senator Levin was first elected to the U.S. Senate in 1978. Prior to that he was a member of the Detroit City Council and served as general counsel to the Michigan Civil Rights Commission during the turbulent early 1960s. Senator Levin is chairman of the Senate Armed Services Committee and the Permanent Committee
