
Overview

One of the functions of REGIS is to not only supply up-to-date data and user assistance to Participant communities and organizations, but also to provide applications in which the data may be viewed, analyzed, queried and output. To that end, all REGIS Participants have access to several GIS applications via a centralized architecture using high-speed connections.



Traditionally, the higher-end GIS users have had access to the ESRI ArcGIS suite of applications, such as ArcView, ArcEditor and ArcInfo. Now REGIS members along with members of the public can access multiple mapping applications including:

- Parcel Finder
- Park Finder
- Cemetery Finder
- Census Map
- Utility Finder (members only)

These applications can easily be accessed by visiting the REGIS website at www.gvmc-regis.org Each eREGIS module is designed for users to quickly and easily answer questions about publicly available data. The members only Utility Finder has been designed to offer REGIS members an efficient way to gain access to REGIS data layers but in a simpler and more user-friendly format than the ArcGIS programs.
