### II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Referring to Item II: Attachment A & B, Van Wyngarden entertained a motion to approve the minutes from the November 15th, 2023, Policy Committee meeting and January 24<sup>th</sup>, 2024, combined Technical and Policy Committee meeting.

MOTION by Madura, SUPPORT by LaFave, to approve the Policy Committee minutes dated November 15, 2023, and combined Technical and Policy Committee minutes dated January 24, 2024. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

# III. OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

### IV. <u>TIP AMENDMENTS</u>

# Referring to Item IV: Attachment A,

 MDOT requested approval for changes in added phases, year, and costs as identified in the agenda packet. The added CON phase for Phragmite control and the moving of the PE phase for Leonard St to FY26 are needing federal approval as line items. The added ROW phases for M-37 SB and US-131 are contributing to the need for a GPA threshold amendment for Trunkline Traffic Operations and Safety, along with moving their M-37 project to FY24 for Signal Modernization.

- T. Kent provided updates on the projects from the S/TIP Exempt List.
- OCRC has been awarded bridge funds for Adams Street over Kampen-Struk Drain and needs to be added to the TIP. This has triggered a GPA amendment for Local Bridge.
- On behalf of Walker, KCRC and The Rapid the following administrative modifications to the FY2023-2026 TIP were requested and were presented to the Policy Committee for discussion. Staff estimates there will be no need for federal amendments or GPA threshold changes.
  - The City of Walker's FY24 Center Dr. Roundabout project has come in under budget, freeing up Carbon Reduction funds that will be flexed to The Rapid for buses in FY24.
  - KCRC is moving their 84th @ Cherry Valley project from FY24 to FY26, freeing up CMAQ funds to be flexed to The Rapid in FY24 for buses.
  - The Rapid will transfer CMAQ funds gained in FY24 back to KCRC in FY26 to better align with the timing of their 84th @ Cherry Valley project.
  - Joseph and Wisselink clarified the reasons for the swapping of funds.

MOTION by Schmalzel, SUPPORT by Pachla, to approve the TIP amendments and modifications requested by MDOT, Ottawa County Road Commission, Kent County Road Commission, Walker, and The Rapid. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

## V. Draft 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan

Referring to Item V: Attachment A, Faber stated that staff has completed the first draft of the 2050 MTP and is asking for the Committee's approval to bring the document to the public for comment. Faber reviewed the milestones that have been completed up to this point and mentioned several upcoming public engagement opportunities.

MOTION by Thornton, SUPPORT by Sprague, to approve bringing the Draft 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan forward for public comment. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

# V. FY2025 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)

- Joseph mentioned the UPWP and asked the group for input on development.
- Joseph mentioned the Public Participation Plan will be updated.
- The Transportation Demand Management plan is done and will be used to fill in TDM tasks in 2025 UPWP.
- Committees and staff have a desire to work together on active transportation facilities.
- Joseph also mentioned the potential safety audit program. Schweitzer asked about staff capacity, Joseph mentioned that new staff is helping with workload.

# VI. OTHER BUSINESS

### Asset Management Vehicle Map Application

- Zonyk presented the recently developed pavement data condition application, which
  provides users with PASER data, and the data and images collected by GVMC's
  pavement data collection vehicle.
- Sprague mentioned that KCRC has used this application to show where there are deficiencies and help validate issues.

# Safety Action Plan

 Joseph mentioned that the consultant has developed the draft high-injury network and is developing the high-risk network. The consultant team will be starting public engagement for the plan.

### **MDOT Updates**

- T. Kent mentioned M-37 through the Village of Caledonia will begin development.
- T. Kent mentioned projects that will impact travel along US-131 this construction season, including directional closures. MDOT will host a virtual public meeting at the end of March regarding a project that will close US-131 at Plaster Creek in April/May.
