RE: FY2020-2023 Transportation Improvement Program

On behalf of MDOT, Caledonia, Kentwood, Wyoming, and The Rapid, the following amendments/modifications to the FY2020-2023 TIP are being requested. Here are the specific requests:

- MDOT is requesting the amendments/modifications to the TIP project list in the attached pending projects summary. These include two projects that were originally programmed in the FY 2020-2023 TIP, but that have been moved out to later years. MDOT is also requesting committee review of the S/TIP exempt project list, which has been modified to only show the projects that have undergone changes since the last Committee meeting. MDOT staff may highlight a few of note during the meeting (please see attachments).
- Caledonia is requesting an amendment of their FY2021 Kinsey Ave project, which has decreased in cost by over 25% with the latest engineer's estimate (see pending projects/GPAs report).
- Staff, on behalf of the City of Kentwood, is requesting an amendment to the FY2022 TIP, adding the Burton Street project that was approved by Committees in May. This addition has triggered a GPA threshold amendment for the FY2022 Local Road GPA (please see pending projects/GPAs report).
- Wyoming has received their conditional commitment for the Plaster Creek Trail
 project, and therefore staff, on their behalf, is requesting an amendment to add it
 to the TIP. This addition has triggered a GPA threshold amendment to the

FY2022 Local Livability and Sustainability GPA (please see pending projects/GPAs report).

• Staff, on behalf of ITP-The Rapid, is requesting to add the portion of the Transit Master Plan planning project that was approved by Committees for HIP-Covid Relief funding to FY2023.

RE: Public Participation Plan (PPP) Approval

Federal law requires an MPO to have a public participation process that is explicitly set forth and maintained. GVMC's public participation process is outlined in our Public Participation Plan (PPP). This document is reviewed at the beginning of the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) development cycle and updated, if necessary. GVMC determined it was necessary to update the Public Participation Plan to address virtual meetings and virtual public outreach, changes to the Policies and Practices document, and amending the document. Numerous smaller updates were also made to the document during the review process.

In May of 2021, Staff presented the revised <u>draft PPP</u> to the Technical and Policy Committees for consideration. At that time, both Committees recommended the document be brought to the public for the mandatory 45-day public comment period, which began on Saturday, May 22, and ran through Friday, July 9, for a total public comment period of 49 days.

GVMC staff received four public comments during the comment period, which are included along with staff responses in Appendix F of the document. None of the comments have resulted in changes to the content of the original draft document that was presented in May. Staff has made some very minor editorial changes to the document, but again, nothing that significantly impacted the content or the public participation processes set forth in the document.

<u>Recommended Action:</u> Staff is requesting that the Policy Committee approve the draft Public Participation Plan.
